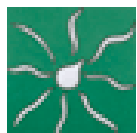

**Introduction**

The Symposium will be of interest to a diverse audience of scientists from different branches of fundamental and applied nematology because various theoretical and practical problems of nematology will be covered at the plenary, symposium and poster sessions. Special attention will be given to current achievements in classical and molecular taxonomy, systematic, phylogenetics, the host-parasite interactions, nematode ecology and bioindication. Among the purposes of the Symposium is a consolidation of the unity of the active working nematology groups in Russia and scientific centres from different countries.

**Location**

Petrozavodsk, the capital of Karelia, is situated on the shore of the beautiful Lake Onego, 400 km to the North of St. Petersburg. The city is the largest centre of education and culture in North-West Russia. You can get to Petrozavodsk by comfortable night trains running daily from St. Petersburg (9 hours) or Moscow (14 hours) or by bus from Helsinki (about 10 hours). Airplane transportation is also available, but the flights are rare and subject to change frequently. We shall inform the participants on the current situation on the availability of air flights. As Petrozavodsk is a popular recreation place, the participants who wish to stay in the town after or before the symposium are advised to make special reservation in advance.

## Symposium venue

The Symposium will take place in the main building of the Karelian Research Centre of RAS (Pushkinskaya St., 11). Presentations will be held in two Conference Halls. All facilities (conference facilities, accommodation and meals) are within easy walking distance of each other.
